2. FILL THE RED LUNCH BAG (FOUND AT TARGET), WITH TRADITIONAL TREATS:
 - CLEMENTINE
 - GOLD CHOCOLATE COINS
 - CANDY CANE
 - I ALSO LIKE TO GIVE A NEW PAIR OF WOOL SOCKS EACH YEAR.
3. PUT THE CARD WITH THE SYMBOLIC MEANING OF THE GIFTS INSIDE THE BAG, AND ATTACH SAINT NICHOLAS FACE TO THE TOP WITH A STAPLER. TAPE THE CROZIER TO HIS BODY.
4. GIFT TO YOUR CHILDREN, OR OTHERS, ON SAINT NICHOLAS DAY, DECEMBER 6TH.
