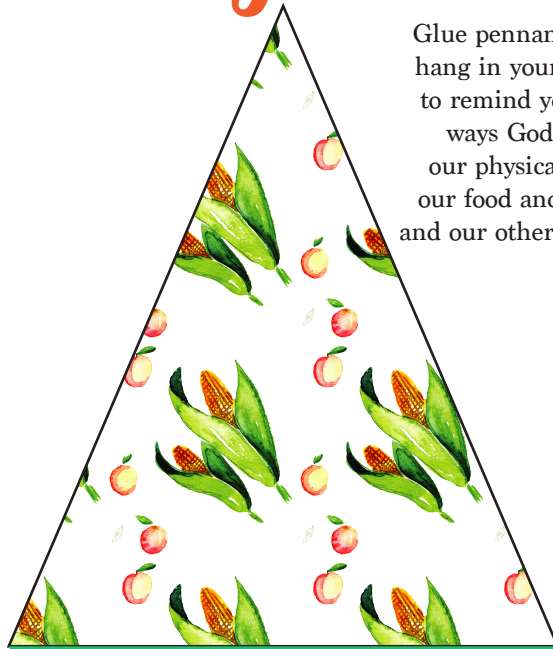


# Rogation Day Prayer Bunting

Glue pennants onto a string to hang in your home or garden to remind you to pray for the ways God sustains us in our physical environments: our food and how it is grown, and our other material blessings.



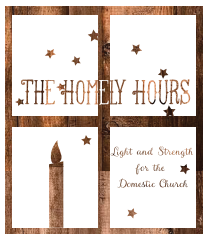
For favorable weather,

Amen



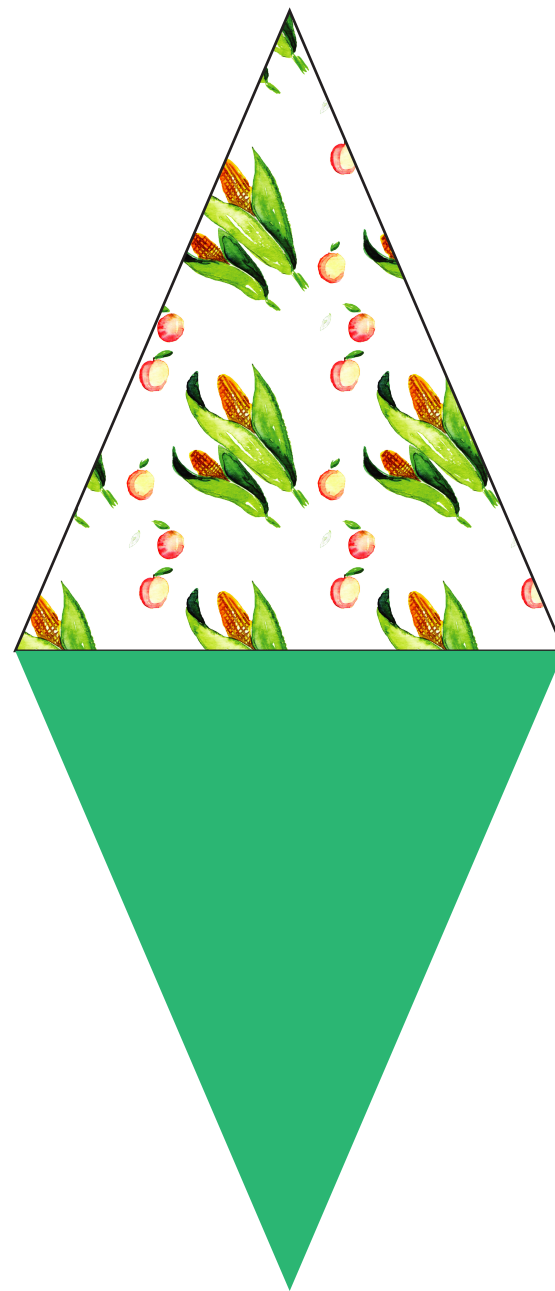
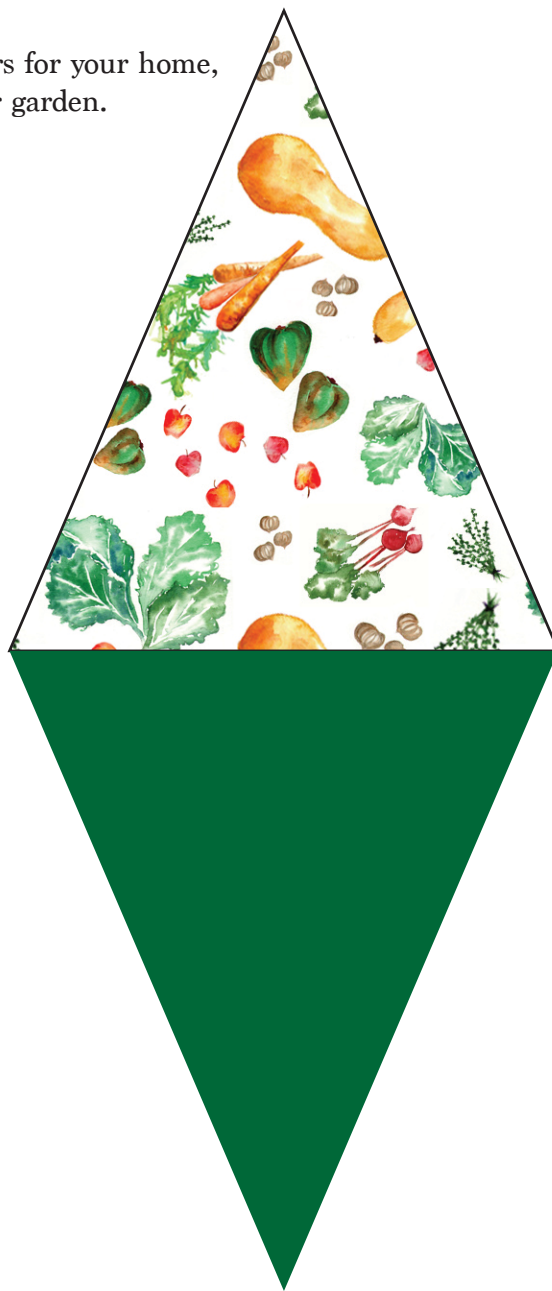
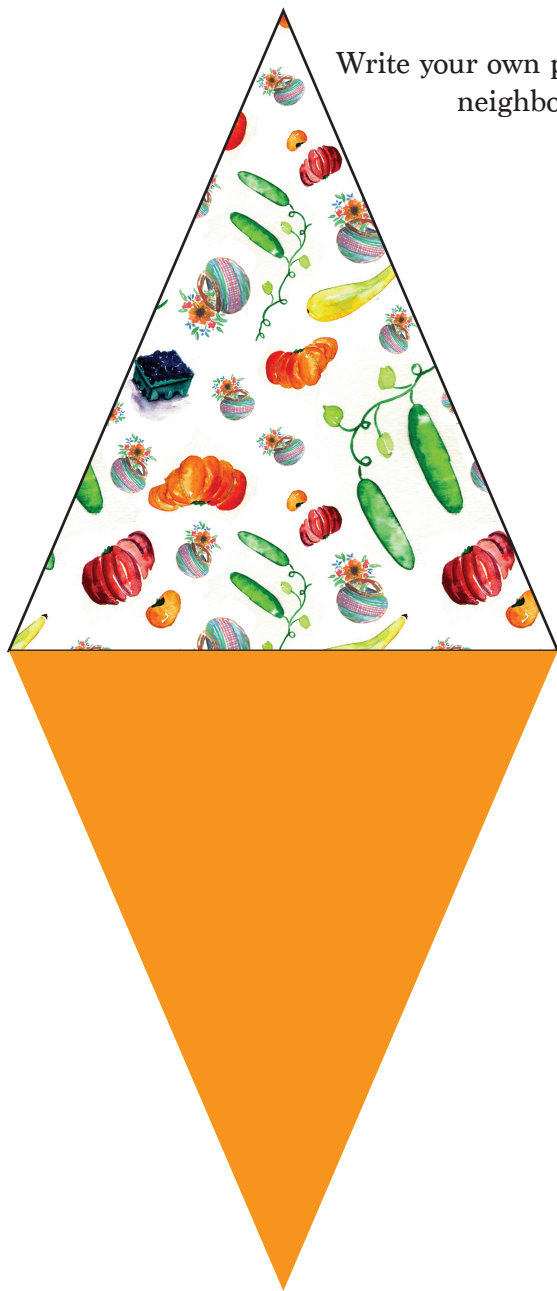
For your blessing
